**Subject:** Passenger shelters

Hello

We have been contacted by Lancashire County Council who have a significant amount of capital funding to refurbish the shelters on the mainline route from Burnley to Colne. They are about to start a tendering exercise and intend to start work on the ground in October. As we understand it, as well as the initial refurbishment they have resource to cover future maintenance for 5 years.

To do this however they require that ownership of the shelters is transferred to them. As you will know we transferred shelters in your areas to your councils in 2016.

In Colne's case we transferred 35 of which 11 are on the mainline.

In Brierfield's case we transferred 8 of which 7 are on the mainline.

In Reedley Hallows' case we transferred 5 all of which are on the mainline.

Pendle still retains **all** those in the area of Nelson Town Council.

The County Council will also be approaching Primesight who own the bus shelters on the route **which have** advertising panels with a view to negotiating to take over ownership of them and including them in the programme.

I have agreed with the County Council to sound you out as to whether you would be prepared to transfer ownership to them to enable the project to proceed. Pendle will be shortly considering its own position as regards those shelters it still owns. On the face of it, it sounds like an advantageous proposal.

Could you arrange for your Council to consider this and let me know the outcome. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any queries.
